SUBJECT: Union Pacific Railroad Pipeline Crossing Agreement

BACKGROUND:

This agreement allows the City to install one, 8-inch encased potable and fire water pipeline crossing and one, 3-inch domestic water pipeline crossing in the same casing pipeline on Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRC) property at Mile Post 448.65 to service the Boise Train Depot. The original water lines that service the Boise Train Depot are being replaced and require a new license agreement with UPRC for a modern utility crossing. In exchange for this license, the City will pay UPRC a one-time license fee of \$2,700.00.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The City will pay Union Pacific Railroad Company a one-time license fee of \$2,700.00.
