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**BACKGROUND:**

The Public Works Department solicited proposals for anticipated services that include geotechnical engineering and laboratory testing and analysis for such items as soil compaction, hillside stability, pavement restoration, pavement design and evaluation, site investigations, exploratory borings, in-situ testing of soils, seepage and dewatering analysis, soil management and erosion control, construction support and monitoring, geo-hazards evaluation, settlement analysis, rebar inspection, concrete strength testing, building foundation design and testing, etc. Services may also involve planning, construction document preparation, services during construction, and other miscellaneous services.

**BID RESULTS:**

The proposals were opened July 26, 2017, at 1:00 p.m. local time. Eleven (11) companies received plan sets and were entered on the plan holders list. Two (2) proposals were received.

Public Works staff reviewed the proposals for accuracy, completeness, and responsiveness. The proposals were evaluated on the selection criteria included in the specification to rank the proposals. The best qualified/highest ranked proposer with significant local preference, Materials Testing and Inspection, has been contacted by Public Works staff and indicated that they would like to proceed with the project.

## CITY OF BOISE

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Finance and Administration and Public Works Department staff recommend that RFP 17-369B is awarded to the best qualified/highest ranked proposer with significant local preference, Materials Testing and Inspection, not to exceed budget. The initial contract is for one (1) year with the option of three (3) one year renewals. Award of this contract is subject to compliance requirements.

Department has confirmed sufficient funding is available for this obligation.


