BACKGROUND:

The State of Idaho has a statewide contract with Les Schwab Tire Centers, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, and Michelin North America, Idaho State Contracts SBPO 17200705, PADD 1099, PADD 1100 and PADD 1101, which provides for tires, tire maintenance, and supplies. This request is to gain authorization to procure tires and supplies for citywide use off of Idaho State Contract SBPO 17200705 from Les Schwab Tire Centers, off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1099 from Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1100 from Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, and off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1101 from Michelin North America, not to exceed tires, tire maintenance, and supplies budget for FY18.

Finance and Administration staff anticipate that the purchases from Les Schwab Tire Centers, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, and Michelin North America will exceed \$50,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

Finance and Administration staff recommend authorization to procure CP 18-002 tires, tire maintenance, and supplies for Citywide use from Les Schwab Tire Centers off of Idaho State

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Contract SBPO 17200705, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1099, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1100, and Michelin North America off of Idaho State Contract PADD 1101, not to exceed tires, tire maintenance, and supplies budget for FY18.

This purchase is being made pursuant to Idaho Code § 67-2803(1) - Idaho State or Political Subdivision Contract.

Department has confirmed sufficient funding is available for this obligation.

WHEREAS, the State of Idaho has a statewide contract with Les Schwab Tire Center, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, and Michelin North America, Idaho State Contracts SBPO 17200705, PADD 1099, PADD 1100 & PADD 1101, for Tires, Tire Maintenance, and Supplies; and,

WHEREAS, Finance and Administration Department staff recommend authorization to procure CP 18-002 Tires, Tire Maintenance, and Supplies for Citywide Use, from Les Schwab Tire Center, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation and Michelin North America, off of Idaho State Contracts SBPO 17200705, PADD 1099, PADD 1100 & PADD 1101, not to exceed tires, tire maintenance, and supplies budget for FY18.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOISE CITY, IDAHO:

Section 1. That authorization to procure CP 18-002 Tires, Tire Maintenance, and Supplies for Citywide Use by and between the city of Boise City and Les Schwab Tire Center, Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company, Bridgestone Americas Tire Operation, and Michelin North America off of Idaho State Contracts SBPO 17200705, PADD 1099, PADD 1100 & PADD 1101, not to exceed tires, tire maintenance, and supplies budget for FY18, is hereby approved.

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.


