BACKGROUND:

In recognition of Cecil D. Andrus' service to Idaho as its longest serving Governor, and his service to the United States of America as Secretary of the Interior, Boise City's Capitol Park shall be renamed "Cecil D. Andrus Capitol Park" in his honor.

Cecil D. Andrus Capitol Park is a 2-acre park in downtown Boise, located across the street from the Idaho Capitol. The park features brick walkways, mature shade trees, planting beds with colorful flowers, picnic tables, and park benches. At its center is a central plaza that honors the men and women who serve our country in the military and in public service.

A RESOLUTION HONORING FORMER GOVERNOR CECIL D. ANDRUS BY RENAMING BOISE CITY'S CAPITOL PARK AS "CECIL D. ANDRUS CAPITOL PARK"; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOISE CITY, IDAHO:

Section 1. That Boise City's Capitol Park shall be, and hereby is, renamed "**Cecil D. Andrus Capitol Park**," in honor of former Idaho Governor Cecil D. Andrus, who passed away on August 24, 2017.

Section 2. That Boise City staff shall be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to do all things necessary to accomplish the renaming of Capitol Park to "**Cecil D. Andrus Capitol Park**."

Section 3. That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.


