## **BACKGROUND:**

Public parking in the downtown corridor and around the Boise State University ("University") campus is congested and demand will become more acute for the limited public parking in these areas as the population continues to grow in the City of Boise ("City"). To address the ongoing parking issues in these areas, the City and University agreed to conduct a pilot park and ride program from June through September of this year. The pilot program used the University's Elder Street parking lot, (located at 2891 Elder Street, Boise, Idaho 83705), and University supplied shuttle buses to transport program participants to the University campus and the City Center Plaza on Main Street. Under the pilot program, a minimum sixty (60) parking spaces at the Elder Street parking facility were reserved for use by downtown workers.

During this pilot program the City paid University for the costs of operating the shuttle buses and use of the Elder Street parking lot. The Capital City Development Corporation ("CCDC") partnered with the City of Boise ("City") to finance fifty percent (50%) of the reimbursements paid to University for this pilot program. The Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") set forth with the following resolution memorializes that partnership between City and CCDC and provides for CCDC to reimburse the City for up to forty-eight thousand dollars (\$48,000.00) to cover half of the pilot program costs that City has paid to University. Additionally, the MOU requires that CCDC remit their payment before October 1, 2017, upon invoicing by the City.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

CCDC shall pay the City for expenses incurred NTE \$48,000.00.


