SUBJECT: Idaho Water Resource Board Flood Management Grant

BACKGROUND:

On June 21, 2019, City of Boise submitted a flood management grant funding request of \$6,371.00 for a flood repair project on a low section of Crane Creek adjacent to Esther Simplot Pond, which has been experiencing regular flooding during high flows. The breaching of the stream bank causes significant erosion, damaging the adjacent nature trail, and deposits significant amounts of sediment in Crane Creek, Esther Simplot Pond, and the Boise River.

Idaho Water Resource Board (Board) staff determined that Boise City's application complied with the intent of the Board's Flood Management Grant Program to assist qualified entities in pursuing flood-damaged stream channel repair, stream channel improvement, flood risk reduction, and flood prevention projects.

Board staff reviewed the City's proposed budget and determined that the costs are reasonable and there are other funds as described in the budget to match the Board's contribution.

On July 26, 2019, the Board approved a \$6,371.00 flood management grant to the City of Boise to implement stream bank and nature trail repairs, installation of an ultra-block spillway, new pedestrian bridge to enhance public safety, erosion protection for the bank and channel bottom, and revegetation of the disturbed areas. The stream bank repairs and spillway will prevent flooding of Crane Creek and reduce the amount of sediment being deposited into Crane Creek, Esther Simplot Pond, and the Boise River.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Anticipated cost for the project is approximately \$21,236. The grant awarded by the Idaho Water Resource Board is for

\$6,371.00. The City will provide a 70% match of \$14,865. The City has sufficient funds to cover the project.


