BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this contract is to continue the design process awarded through the Julia Davis Design Competition. The RFQ for the design competition was assembled by Purchasing and Boise Parks Department and was advertised in the Idaho Statesman on November 9, 16, and 23 of 2005. The RFQ package was sent out to 38 firms in Idaho, Washington, Oregon, Colorado, Utah, and Vermont. The teams submitted their qualifications on January 13, 2006, and the Competition Jury scored each team based on experience and compliance with the design competition requirements. Three teams were chosen as finalists and then submitted conceptual designs on May 26, 2006. Public input was sought during two public displays of the conceptual designs in June 2006, where public comments were accepted. The Competition Jury then selected and awarded the winning teams and their conceptual designs on July 28, 2006. As stipulated in the Design Competition, “the Team whose concept designs have been cited for awards by the Competition Jury will be offered contracts for the completion of the professional services required to complete the design documents as funds become available for their construction.”

Since the construction of the elements within the Julia Davis Design Competition Masterplan are tied to the fund-raising efforts of the Julia Davis Coalition, this Task Order will need to remain in place for several years.

Through the continued efforts of the Julia Davis Coalition, funds are available for the design and construction of elements within the Julia Davis Design Competition Masterplan.

RECOMMENDATION:

CITY OF BOISE

Finance and Administration and Parks and Recreation staff recommend that IFB 09-093 be renewed for one (1) year, beginning December 31, 2019, and ending December 30, 2020, not to exceed \$108,000.00 (Task Order Basis). This is the third (3rd) annual renewal allowed by the Agreement as amended.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

Department has confirmed sufficient funding is available for this obligation.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE RENEWAL OF IFB 09-093, JULIA DAVIS DESIGN PROJECT, BETWEEN THE CITY OF BOISE CITY (PARKS AND RECREATION) AND LANDMARK DESIGN; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO RESPECTIVELY EXECUTE AND ATTEST SAID AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Department of Finance and Administration and Parks and Recreation staff recommended award of IFB 09-093, Julia Davis Design Project, to the best qualified proposer, LandMark Design; and

WHEREAS, during their meeting of January 13, 2009, the City Council followed staff recommendation and awarded Resolution 20382 for the IFB 09-093 contract to Landmark Design for a term that expired December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the original contract completion date term was modified by Amendment executed by Landmark Design and City staff to permit release of work as funds become available through Julia Davis Coalition and/or the City; and

WHEREAS, during their meeting of September 25, 2018, the City Council authorized the most recent renewal term through the award of Resolution No. 416-18 to LandMark Design; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Agreement be renewed for a one-year period; and

WHEREAS, LandMark Design has agreed to renew the contract under the terms and conditions as specified in the attached renewal letter; and

WHEREAS, this is the third (3rd) renewal allowed by the Agreement as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOISE CITY, IDAHO:

Section 1. That the Renewal by and between the city of Boise City and LandMark Design for IFB 09-093, Julia Davis Design Project, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, be, and the same is hereby, approved as to both form and content.

Section 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized to respectively execute and attest said Agreement for and on behalf of the city of Boise City.


