

**Office of the City of Boise Mayor
Proclamation**

WHEREAS, the Ada County Commissioners, acting as the Board of Canvassers of Elections have canvassed the votes cast in the City of Boise on November 5, 2019, concerning Proposition One (An initiative requiring voter approval of the cost, financing, location, design, and size of certain Boise City library facility projects) and Proposition Two (An initiative requiring voter approval of the cost, financing, location, design, and size of certain sport stadium facility projects); and

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2019, the Boise City Council unanimously voted to adopt the November 5, 2019, canvassed election results into the Council’s work session minutes as set forth in Idaho Code § 34-1813; and

WHEREAS, the canvassed results show that Proposition One received fifty-one thousand, four hundred twenty-three (51,423) votes in total, of which thirty-five thousand, five hundred forty-five (35,545) votes were cast “Yes” for said proposition, fifteen thousand, eight hundred seventy-eight (15,878) votes were cast “No” against said proposition; and

WHEREAS, the canvassed results show that Proposition Two received fifty-one thousand, six hundred ninety-four (51,694) votes in total, of which thirty-eight thousand, eight hundred sixty-eight (38,868) votes were cast “Yes” for said proposition, twelve thousand, eight hundred twenty-six (12,826) votes were cast “No” against said proposition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, David H. Bieter, Mayor of the City of Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho, pursuant to Idaho Code § 34-1813, do hereby proclaim that Proposition One and Proposition Two have been approved and passed by a majority of the voters in the November 5, 2019, Boise City election, and are thus in full force and effect as law within the City of Boise from the date of this proclamation.
